

“AMST 2026” Book Chapter Formatting (MS Word)

- **Plagiarism:** submit original/ review work. Allowed similarity should not exceed 10 % (excluding references) and use of AI is as per the latest UGC guideline.
- **Page limit:** 4-5 pages
- **Page Setup:** A4 size, 1-inch margins on all sides.
- **Font Family:** Times New Roman.
- **Font Size:** 12-point for body text; 14-point (bold) for headings; 16-point (bold) for the chapter title.
- **Figure & Table:** With appropriate caption and numbering
- **Line Spacing:** single spacing lines for the main text
- **Paragraph Alignment:** Justified.
- **Section Numbering:** Arabic numerals (1, 2, 3, etc.) for main headings; 1.1, 1.2 for sub-headings.

Structure of the Book Chapter

The submitted book chapter should typically follow this order:

1. **Title Page:** Chapter title, author name(s), institutional affiliation(s), and complete contact details.
2. **Abstract:** A brief summary of your chapter (up to 150 words).
3. **Keywords:** 5 keywords related to your topic.
4. **Introduction:** Literature review, Background and objective of the study.
5. **Main Body:** Methodology, and data analysis/results/discussion.
6. **Conclusion:** Summary of findings and scope for future research.
7. **Reference format:** numbering in Arabic numerals (1, 2, 3.).
